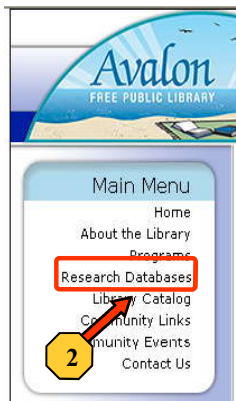


EBSCOhost is a collection of databases primarily containing full text or annotated entries of magazine or journal articles covering current events, education, health, medicine, consumer information, and business. EBSCOhost also includes encyclopedia articles, grade-appropriate materials for schoolchildren, and images.

Accessing

1. On the home page select "Research Databases"
2. On the database page, scroll down to the "General Reference" section.
3. Select "EBSCOhost"

4. If accessing EBSCO other than in the library, type your library card number in

the "Login Box". Use of EBSCO in the library does not require logging in.

Databases

The databases in EBSCOhost can be searched either singly or in combinations. The databases include:

MasterFILE Premier includes over 1700 general publications with many full text articles dating back to 1975

TOPICsearch is orientated to current events.

Newspaper Source contains selected full text articles from from 30 national and international newspapers, 200 regional newspapers and television / radio news transcripts.

McClatchy-Tribune Collection includes a 90 day archive of approximately 290 newspapers of the McClatchy-Tribune Collection.

Business Source Premier provides superior resources in many areas of business including marketing, management, MIS, POM, accounting, finance, and economics

Corporate Resource Net is designed to meet the diverse information needs of today's companies with access to over 1200 magazines.

Regional Business News incorporates coverage of 75 business journals, newspapers and newswires from metropolitan and rural areas in the U.S.

Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia

EBSCO Animals provides in-depth information on a variety of topics related to animals.

Primary Search provides age appropriate magazine articles for elementary students. Includes reading level indicators (Lexiles).

Middle Search Plus includes magazine articles for middle and jr. high school, primary

source documents, biographies, and an image collection. Lexiles are provided.

Academic Search Premier is billed as the world's largest academic, multidisciplinary database.

Health Source (Consumer Edition) provides access to over 150 journals providing health information on a variety of topics.

Health Source (Nursing/Academic Edition) includes scholarly full-text journals focusing on many medical disciplines.

Clinical Pharmacology provides access to clinically relevant drug monographs for prescription drugs, Herbal and nutritional supplements, over the counter products, and investigational drugs.

Journals in each Database

To determine if a journal or magazine is in a database:

1. Go to "Choose Database" and scroll to the database that is most relevant to your research.
2. Click on "Title List"



3. Either type the title of the magazine in the "Browse Publication" box or select the appropriate letter from the alphabet index..
