MONTH IN REVIEW



Significant gain in patron base vs. June 2021, primarily growth in nonresident, seasonal and county card holders.



Circulation of books remained strong last year and grew every month in 2022. Was only 2% down from June 2019. Print circulation 19% higher than last June.



Strongest monthly figures since the return to in-person programming. The most well-attended event was An Evening with Ray Didinger (230).



HC programs including Trivia Night, the Annual AHS House Tour, and Kids' Mini Camp drove visitation and increased engagement.



Tech use, including Wi-Fi and printing, continues to be up over 2021 figures.



Foot traffic is moving closer to 2019 figures (10,055), was up 30% over 2021.
