

AVALON LIBRARY & HISTORY CENTER REPORT

DECEMBER 2023

Highlights

- 2023 Community Survey distributed in December as of early January nearly 650 responses have been received.
- Various metrics closed out 2023 at their highest in the past five years overall circulation, event attendance, and website visits. Areas where future growth is sought onsite visits, patrons, social media engagement. Patron base is currently 4% under (preCOVID) 2019 figures aiming to meet or exceed in 2024.
- Offseason special kids' events continue to draw crowds over 170 patrons in attendance at the annual Happy Noon Year event!

Areas of Focus

- 2024-2026 Strategic Plan Compiling feedback from the 2023 Community Survey. Preparing reach out to individuals who expressed interest in participating in focus groups.
- Personnel
 - o PT Museum Assistants & FT Program Assistant Reviewed applications and completed interview process. Hiring recommendations anticipated for January 2024.
 - o Recording Secretary received notice of retirement from current Board Recording Secretary, preparing documentation to post an opening for the position.
 - o Anticipate new employee manual from Borough of Avalon. Will identify policy changes that require attention.
- History Center Facility Anticipate moving forward with phase two (2nd floor) in January, once quoting process is complete.
- Potential Building Projects Aim to meet again in January with the BOE architect to resolve remaining questions about any available expansion options.
- Marketing RFP 2023 Currently open scheduled to close on January 18, 2024. Anticipated for consideration in February.

Strategic Goals

Engage (Marketing, Service, Community & Staff Engagement, and Events)

- Events
 - o Summer 2024 Planning continues for community partnerships, concerts, and speaker events.
 - Staff continue to investigate new approaches for author events.
 - o Yay It's Thursday new series to expand offseason weekday kids programming, based on feedback from the fall 2023 pilot program.
- Marketing
 - o Preparing plans for spring and summer 2024.
 - o Developing a brochure focused on kids' resources for outreach distribution.
- Outreach
 - Little Free Library Selected and purchased a freestanding Little Free Library to be placed at the History Center, part of a strategic staff initiative.

Enhance (Library & History Center use and facilities, Collections, and Digital Resources)

- Internet Library bandwidth expanded as part of an ongoing 2023 project to ensure sufficient internet quality for patron and staff use.
- Donation A series of donations were made in late 2023 in memory of a long-time library patron. Collection items will be purchased and marked to note the contributions.
